

# NEET MOTORCYCLE INSTITUTE, LLC

## I. COURSE DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION

The NEET Motorcycle Institute, LLC (“NEET MOTO”) is a state-approved provider of the required three day course that leads to an “M” endorsement to legally operate a motorcycle.

Motorcycles are provided for beginning students and classes are limited to six per class. Now in its third year of operation, the school has a 97% pass rate.

Successful completion of the course enables graduates to obtain their license at the department of motor vehicles (DMV) *without testing*. **NEET MOTO administers both the written and skills exams that fulfill all state requirements to obtain a license.**

All instruction is presented by Christopher Hess, a Motorcycle Safety Foundation certified RiderCoach.

## II. ELIGIBILITY AND RESTRICTIONS

All students of NEET Moto are required to possess a current driver’s license (from any state). Persons with suspended licenses are not eligible for training.

The minimum age to enroll is 15 years of age with parental consent [and other requirements](#).

Persons over 60 years of age are encouraged to contact NEET MOTO prior to registering.

## III. EQUIPMENT AND RESTRICTIONS

All students are required to possess (or borrow) the following personal protective gear to participate:

- (1) A helmet with a DOT approved sticker.
- (2) Shatter-proof eyewear, unless the helmet includes a face shield
- (3) Long-sleeve shirt
- (4) Durable jeans (defined as pants without holes)
- (5) Sturdy, over-the-ankle footwear. *No tennis shoes are allowed.*

Cell phone monitoring and texting are **not allowed** during “behind-the-bar” instruction or classroom instruction. Students can “check in” with their phones during rest breaks that generally occur every hour.

**IV. FEES AND DISCOUNTS**

The standard cost of instruction is \$250 with two types of available discounts:

- A. For each six-person class, one student will be reimbursed half of their tuition (\$125) by scoring the highest on the written exam and skills test to become the “honor graduate.” Ties will be settled by a clutch control contest.
- B. Once each month, a class for persons who possess their own motorcycle (and will not use the units owned by NEET MOTO) can take the course for \$150. To be eligible, riders must present registration verifying they personally own the motorcycle unit and proof of insurance. Rider-owned motorcycles are subject to inspection.

**V. REGISTRATION PROCEDURES**

Sign-up using Paypal or pay by check or cash in person. Please bring your driver’s license on the first night of class. Personal protective gear will only be needed for the weekend portions.
